Receive research projects with read permissions

Users can now use the Windows client to share search projects to other users with read permissions.

Users can thus see evaluations and patent statuses, but cannot edit or create new values.

Shared search projects can also be opened in the Web client.

The shared projects are marked with a user icon:

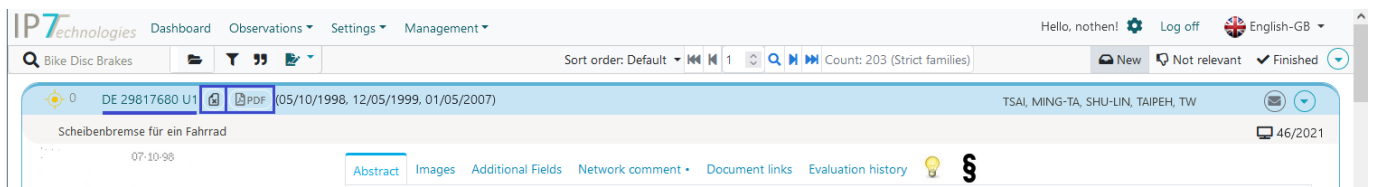

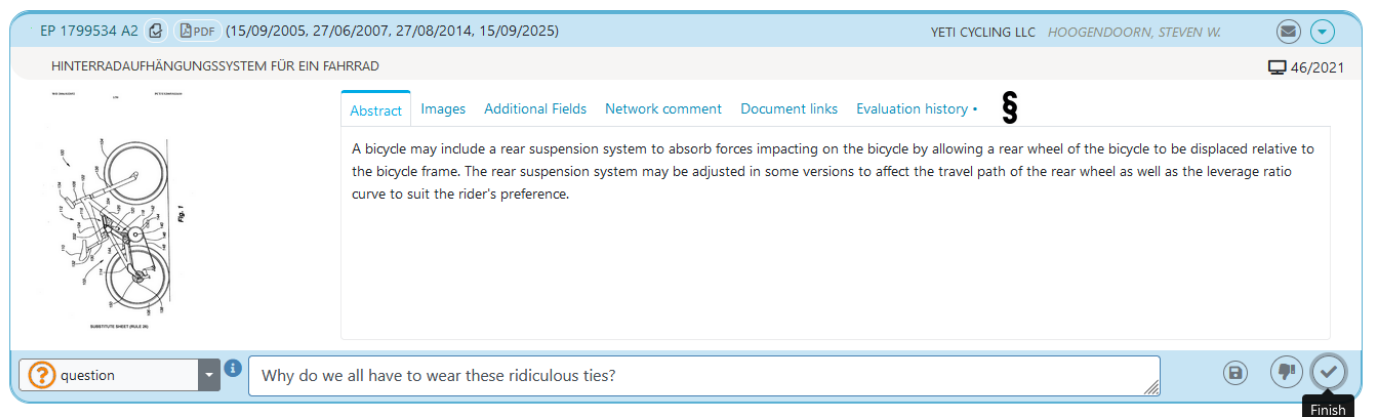

Improvements

- The view or buttons of the result list have been adapted to the view as in the Windows client. The detailed view is opened by clicking on the patent number.



- The administrators can set mandatory folders for the assignment in monitoring tasks. For this we have now improved the error message, so that the users see these folders immediately.

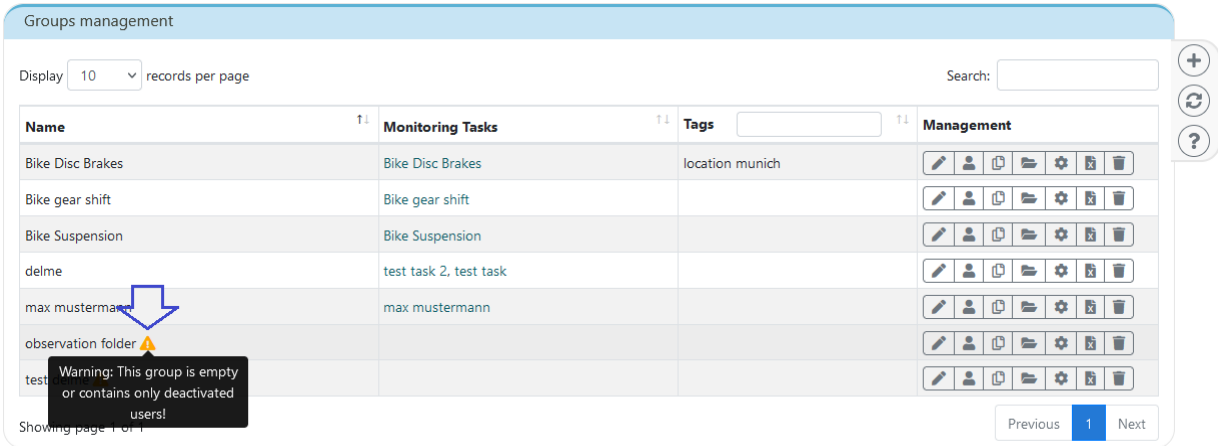

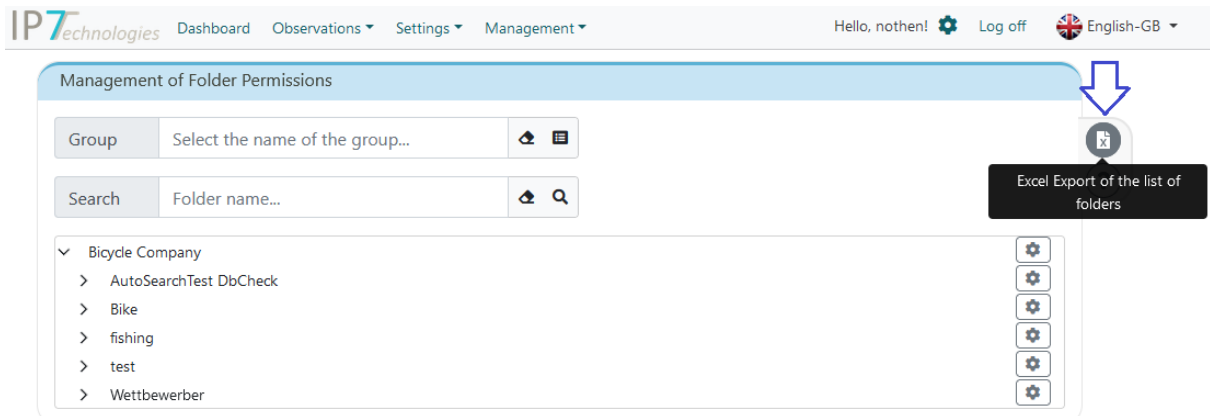


Thus, for example, patents that are viewed in the course of observation (family/legal status monitoring) can be forwarded more easily to other users or tasks.

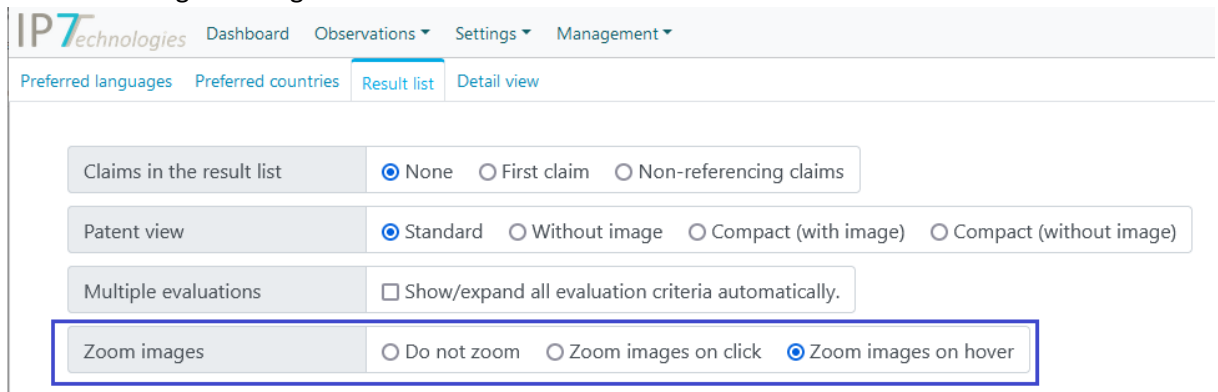
